Final Two Lesson Bond

I make it painless for any student to their stop lessons at any time. All they need to do is give me **two weeks** notice via email. (This gives me some time to find another student to fill up their time slot).

Easy right? You'd be amazed. ☺

Despite this very reasonable notice period, a certain percentage of students will stop their lessons without giving the required two weeks notice. Because of this, all new students enrolling with me will need to pay a **final two lesson bond** with their initial tuition payment. This means...

- If a student gives me the required two weeks notice, then the bond will be used to pay for their final two lessons.
- If a student doesn't give me two weeks notice, then the bond will be forfeited.
